On November 20, 2012, the Court appointed Michael K. Rozen, Esq. as Director of Medical Monitoring (the "Director") in the above-referenced matter to oversee the implementation of the Medical Panel Protocols for the Medical Monitoring Program (the "Program"). The Director has previously submitted eight (8) Status Reports to the Court summarizing the progress and status of planning for implementation of the Medical Panel Protocols, most recently on April 6, 2015.

The Program was launched with a mailing to approximately 98,000 potential Class Members in the beginning of September 2014 and Class Members have been registering, making appointments for monitoring and receiving monitoring pursuant to the Medical Panel Protocols. Each week the Director submits to the parties a Weekly Summary Report with detailed Program Statistics. Attached hereto is the Weekly Summary Report for the week ending April 17, 2015, which sets out in detail the current number of Program participants (6,458 Registrations to date) and their demographics, as well as, among other information, the number of scheduled physician monitoring appointments, the number of approved services, and the total amount approved for payment. Also attached is a CPT Code Summary Report which sets forth the total services approved for payment as of April 17, 2015, by CPT Code.

In the April 6, 2015 Status Report it was noted that we are working aggressively to cure Registrations with document deficiencies, and conferring with DuPont and Plaintiffs' Class Counsel to explore additional mechanisms to cure deficiencies. Last week, DuPont and Plaintiffs' Class Counsel agreed on an Affidavit of Settlement Class Membership. This Affidavit will be mailed to all persons on the current list of deficient Registrants, along with a letter which explains that the Affidavit will be accepted as proof

of their Class Member status and eligibility to participate fully in the C-8 Medical Monitoring Program. The letter will enclose a pre-addressed, postage prepaid envelope for the Class Member to return to the Program the completed Affidavit. The letter enclosing the Affidavit will be mailed to the current list of deficient Registrants this week.

As advised in the Director's last Status Report, the Medical Panel is continuing to work through its ongoing obligations to the Program. A form is currently being finalized that will be sent to Registrants to advise them that the Medical Panel recommends follow-up if the Registrant has new symptoms of probable linked conditions that were not present at the time of the initial medical monitoring appointment. Upon receipt of the finalized form, the Director will send the form to the parties for their review prior to any mailing.
