On November 20, 2012, the Court appointed Michael K. Rozen, Esq. as Director of Medical Monitoring (the "Director") in the above-referenced matter to oversee the implementation of the Medical Panel Protocols for the Medical Monitoring Program (the "Program"). The Director has previously submitted 51 Status Reports to the Court summarizing the progress and status of planning for implementation of the Medical Panel Protocols, most recently on December 5, 2016.

The Program was launched with a mailing of notice packets to approximately 98,000 potential Class Members in the beginning of September 2014 and Class Members have been registering, making appointments for monitoring and receiving monitoring pursuant to the Medical Panel Protocols. Since September 2014, additional notice packets have been mailed to potential Class Members upon request bringing the total number of mailings to 99,048.

Each week the Director submits to the parties a Weekly Summary Report with detailed Program Statistics. Attached hereto is the Weekly Summary Report for the week ending December 16, 2016, which sets out in detail the current number of Program participants (6,660 Registrations to date) and their demographics, as well as, among other information, the number of scheduled physician monitoring appointments, the number of approved services, and the total amount approved for payment. Also attached is a CPT Code Summary Report setting forth the total services approved for payment by the Director through December 13, 2016, by CPT Code.

By agreement of the parties, the Director mails an Affidavit of Settlement Class Membership to all Registrants with insufficient documentation, along with a letter which explains that a completed and notarized Affidavit will be accepted as proof of Class Member status and eligibility to participate fully in the Program. As of December 16, 2016 a total of 5,941 Registrants have been deemed eligible for medical monitoring.

The Director convenes a bi-weekly status call with the parties during which the Director informs the parties of any new developments. The Director is currently working with the Medical Panel to provide the Panel with data from the Medical Monitoring Program that the Panel deems necessary to continue its work evaluating the need for further monitoring. On December 7, 2016, the Administrator's technical team, the Medical Director, and the Medical Panel conferred to discuss the format of the data for the transfer to the Medical Panel. On December 19, 2016, the Panel will be sent all of the requested data points. Upon the Panel's approval, all requested data will be sent to the Panel after all personal information has been removed. It is anticipated that it will take approximately two weeks to prepare and de-identify the requested data after the Medical Panel's approval.

The Director has advised the parties that the Panel has also deemed it essential for its further analysis that it be provided access to data from the C-8 Health Project, currently held by West Virginia University ("WVU"). The parties and the Director agreed that as a result of the Court's January 25, 2013 Order to File C8 Science Panel Data and Establishing Criteria for Future Use of Data, the data could not be accessed without further Court order or consent of the individual participants. The Director, after discussion with and review by the Parties and WVU, sent cover letters and consent forms to each registrant who has participated in the Program requesting his or her consent to release their confidential data to the Medical Director solely for the purpose of allowing the Medical Panel to review de-identified data in order to inform the Panel's recommendations for further medical monitoring under the Program. Signed consents from program participants are now being received; approximately 70% of participants have sent in signed consent forms. At the last bi-weekly status call, the Director reported to the parties WVU's time line and cost estimates for the production of the data. The parties are currently considering their response to WVU's estimates.

The parties continue to work with the Director, his team, and each other in good faith.
