On November 20, 2012, the Court appointed Michael K. Rozen, Esq. as Director of Medical Monitoring (the "Director") in the above-referenced matter to oversee the implementation of the Medical Panel Protocols for the Medical Monitoring Program (the "Program"). The Director previously submitted to the Court reports summarizing the progress and status of planning for implementation of the Medical Panel Protocols on September 20, 2013, November 19, 2013, April 28, 2014 and November 21, 2014.

The Program was launched with a mailing to approximately 98,000 potential Class Members in the beginning of September 2014 and Class Members have been registering, making appointments for monitoring and receiving monitoring pursuant to the Medical Panel Protocols. Each week the Director submits to the parties a Weekly Summary Report with detailed Program Statistics. Attached hereto is the Weekly Summary Report for the week ending January 16, 2015, which sets out in detail the current number of Program participants (over 5,000 to date) and their demographics, as well as, among other information, the number of scheduled physician monitoring appointments, the number of approved services, and the total amount approved for payment. In addition the Director has begun sending the parties a Summary of the number of services approved by CPT Code, which is the code utilized by the medical community and the Program to designate the type of medical service. A CPT Code Summary with a description of the CPT Codes is also attached hereto.

Pursuant to agreement of the parties, on January 19, 2015 publication of town hall meetings to be conducted by the Director on January 29th and January 30th, 2015 began in nine regional

newspapers. At these upcoming town halls the Director will answer any and all questions regarding the Medical Monitoring Program.

In addition, the Medical Panel has submitted to the Director and the Parties some further guidance regarding the periodicity of monitoring in the event a participant tests negative initially for any of the linked conditions. We anticipate making some relevant additions to the Program website which would efficiently and effectively communicate this information to participants, and we will also notify all participating health care providers of the additional guidance.
